The International Geodetic Student Meeting (IGSM) is an annual meeting for Students in the fields of Geodesy, Surveying, Cartography, Geomatics and Geoinformatics. While taking place mostly in Europe, IGSM has gained global interest attracting participants from all around the world.

Meetings are organized by a team of students of the hosting university which is selected during the General Assembly two years in advance.

The first IGSM was organized in the Netherlands by geodesy students from Delft University of Technology.

The organization aims to unite geodesy students from all over the world by organizing the annual IGSM. These meetings provide a wonderful chance to exchange experiences from geodesy field. Taking place at different universities every year, these meetings also allow participants to get to know other countries' customs and culture. At present, 92 universities and schools from 34 countries belong to IGSO.
